Re: Public Health Order August 24, 2021

From government of Manitoba “Mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination

Manitoba has announced that designated employees who work with vulnerable populations must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 by October 31, 2021 and must provide proof of vaccination to their employer OR undergo frequent COVID-19 testing. The requirement, by Public Health Order, will include all health care workers employed by or working in areas of direct patient/resident/client care in either public or private health care settings, including hospitals, licensed long-term care facilities, community, and home care environments.

In order to be compliant with this requirement, individuals must receive their first dose by September 7, 2021. To be fully vaccinated by the end of October, individuals must receive their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine no later than October 17, 2021. “

Visitors, Families, Volunteers, Service Providers and Public Health Order

Our staff and residents comply with the Public Health Order and effective immediately we are asking the families and visitors provide proof of their vaccine status. Please present your vaccine card when you screen in. Masks are to be worn at all times in the building and is mandatory. We will be firm with this policy, and we ask for all to comply.

We can keep our building safe together. Moving forward into fall and the knowledge that our infection rate is already escalating we would appreciate caution in taking residents out for visiting. Visiting at Riverwood Square would be the safest for all concerned if we follow the safety protocols.
